THEFT MITIGATION MOMENTUM AT BNSF

Across the transportation industry, all supply chain participants need to be aware that cargo theft is a growing threat. BNSF is continuing to devote significant resources to protecting the security of your shipments.

We have made significant progress in the fight against cargo theft, but our work is not done.



Active Prevention – 2025 Updates:



- BNSF’s Seal Integrity Reporting (SIR) ratio by volume flat compared to 18% overall cargo theft incident increase across the U.S., showing momentum in our efforts to slow down crime in our communities.
- Total anti-theft investment increased 68% from 2023 to 2025 to provide more resources to protect your freight.

Effective Enforcement



- BNSF Police continue to prevent and disrupt criminals from harming our customers, with +700 arrests, including 27 federal indictments and 52 warrants & court orders.
- We are committed to working with other law enforcement agencies and prosecutors to successfully arrest, charge and convict offenders harming the U.S. economic supply chain.

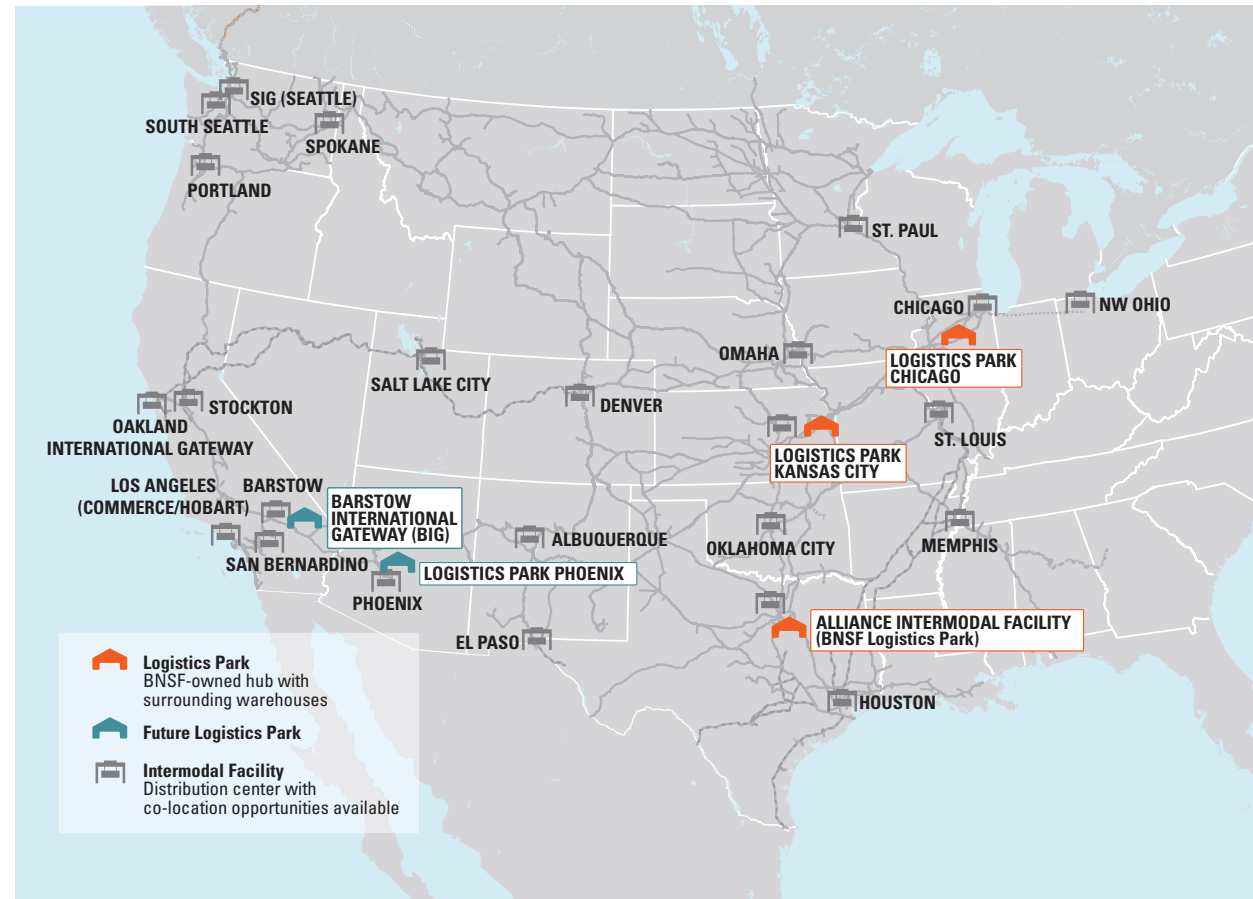

CO-LOCATION LOWERS TOTAL LANDED LOGISTICS COSTS

By combining:

(1) The shorter distance from a BNSF intermodal hub to access a warehouse facility on the nation's largest intermodal network,




(2) With an additional ~25% weight capacity available with heavy weight load capabilities on exempt roads, and

3) The ability to utilize private yard hostlers for drayage,

Co-locating near a BNSF Logistics Park is key to reducing costs and increasing flexibility and resiliency in your supply chain.
